

## A NEW T5040 FOR INDUSTRY AND INVESTMENT

When it came time for the former Department of Primary Industry, now NSW Government Industry and Investment, to update their New Holland TD65D 2WD tractor that they purchased in 2003 they decided on a New Holland T5040 Cab Tractor with a 20F + 20R - 30K transmission which includes Creeper Gears and Hydraulic Power Shuttle. The tractor has Electronic Draft Control with Twin Lift Assist Cylinders and Ground Speed PTO and was specially ordered to suit Industry and Investment's requirements. The New Holland TD65D ROPS tractor traded has very low hours (509) and has been used for work on small trial plots, it is 2WD with 12F+8R+8 Creeper Gears and it would suit a new buyer.

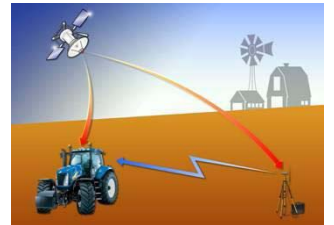

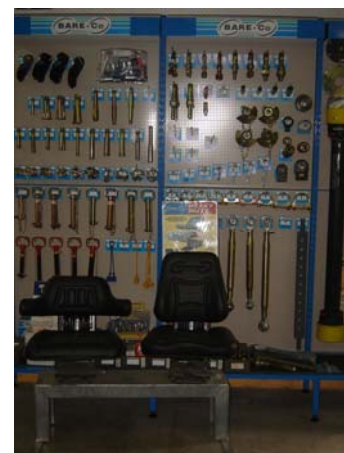
