



THE WARDEN FAMILY'S NEW T6080

The Warden family and Goodwin Kenny have added another chapter to their long business relationship when G W Warden & Co purchased a new New Holland T6080 Range Command tractor with New Holland Challenge L4200S front end loader and 2460mm Heavy Duty bucket. The Warden's Fiat F120 which they purchased new in 1993 had over 14,000 hours on the clock and after all that hard work required some repairs so the Warden family decided it was time to update this tractor. (Mark had a photo of that delivery see photo at right). They have had a number of Fiat tractors over the years and recently purchased a new New Holland T5050 and were impressed with the new New Holland tractor so decided on a New Holland T6080 tractor. During the purchase process Geoff, Mark and Rex all visited the Tamworth Branch to inspect and test drive the tractor. This provided an ideal opportunity to catch up with Geoff and reminisce about the family's history with Goodwin Kenny. The Wardens started farming with an old 1020 McCormick and then progressed to 2 x TEA 20 Fergies, these were updated to the Massey Ferguson 65, which was then replaced by the Fiat 650. One interesting comment from Geoff was that the old McCormick could pull the TEA 20 and the ploughs, or whatever they had in the ground behind them, out of a bog.

Wardens bought their first Fiat tractor, the Fiat 650, new in 1963 (or 1964), they also bought a new baler from Pat Kenny in Gunnedah the year before. In the early days (1960's) Aub Goodwin used to go out to Loomberah and service the TEA 20's – Geoff used to stir Aub regularly about coming out and working on such small tractors, Aub used to return the favour by stirring a "young" Mark up whenever he was there. Geoff remembered going around New Zealand with Aub on a trip and said Aub recorded every bit of the trip on a movie camera.

A NEW T6080 FOR BILL GREENSLADE AT WARONGAH

After running the cropping and grazing operation at Warongah with two New Holland TS115A for the last seven years, Bill came to the conclusion that the farm would operate better with one larger/heavier specialised farming tractor. This tractor will be tasked to working up country, sowing and operating the round baler. The T6080 at 155HP was chosen with Range Command Transmission for flexibility and ease of operation in heavy draught conditions, obviously the fully suspended and very quiet cab along with suspension front axle make the hours spent in the tractor more comfortable. After operating the



BR740A round baler with the new tractor Bill was impressed that there was no engine rev slump and no PTO RPM drop at all, making the baling process much easier and less demanding. A new tractor with less chance of problems and increased resale value were also important considerations. Pictured above right is Tamworth salesman Tony Housden with Bill Greenslade. Warongah traded their older TS115A tractor and upgraded the other TS115A with a new Challenge L4200 Loader. Bill chose this loader because of the improved sight lines (the level lift arms and hoses are enclosed), strength of frame and it comes standard with 3rd Function that is located and covered cleverly to make the sight line through the front of the loader much better. The L4200 has a 4.2m lift height to the bottom pins. Pictured left is Bill Greenslade with the New Holland TS115A with new New Holland/Challenge Loader.

CRAIG AND STUART MURPHY'S NEW T5050

After a run of problems with an older Ford tractor and a big potential repair bill Craig and Stuart Murphy decided to upgrade to a new New Holland T5050 with loader to get reliability for some urgent spraying and be paddock ready to sow on time. The second loader tractor saves them the hassle of moving another tractor between their farms in the Murrurundi/Timor area of the Upper Hunter Valley. The New Holland T5050 was the ideal machine at 97HP with a lower profile to fit in and under timber in their grazing country while clearing up and pasture improving. 
