NOBILI MULCHER FOR THE STOKES FAMILY

John and Samantha Stokes chose a Nobili mulcher for their Duri farm's pasture and crop stubble mulching requirements.

The aim is to mulch the material without windrowing to aid in their farms soil management program. The mulcher will leave a fine layer on top of the soil to aid in moisture retention and assist in building up the soil organic matter levels, thereby increasing pasture production.

The BNG 230 from Nobili has a 2.3m cut with an adjustable rear door to control the degree of mulching or speed of cut in heavier conditions. The Y shaped flails provide good mulching of taller pasture grasses and pasture weeds, the side skids and rear swivelling wheels provide a good range of height adjustment.


