



New England Livestock Group's T7.170

With the decision to improve pasture on the company's property East of Uralla/ Armidale with a 10 tonne spreader, NELG Director, Cameron Grace realised the need to increase horsepower slightly, but also to get the machinery onto a regular upgrade plan to reduce downtime and costs of repairing machinery as it ages. The New Holland T6030 Range Command they had been using was approaching 2,000 hours, so the decision to upgrade to the New Holland T7.170 with Terraglide front suspension was made. The suspension package is required for reduced operator fatigue and reduced machine stress while spreading in the often rocky bumpy paddocks. The New Holland T7.170 has the same Range Command transmission as their old T6030, a slightly larger Challenge L4200 Front End loader and a high volume light materials bucket has been fitted to the T7.170 to assist with loading the chook manure into the spreader. The T7.170 will also be

New Muller Accumulator and Grab for Nic Showell at Armidale

Being time poor, Nic Showell was finding it difficult to handle all the small square bales he makes as part of a small hay contracting business he runs around Armidale with a New Holland Super 417 baler. The solution to the problem was to purchase an accumulator and grab. The Muller 15 bale accumulator was chosen on the recommendation of Goodwin Kenny's Hay Technician Merv Leard for a couple of reasons, one being the electric override to stop dumping while turning a corner and the folding table is also critical to travelling around the district easily. The 15 bale Grab for picking the pack of bales up was fitted with side shift to make truck loading and shed stacking even quicker and easier with the added advantage of being able to make a tidier/tighter stack. Air Filter Maintenance

Well, again this month's maintenance tip comes from the experience of the workshop in recent months. There are generally 2 air cleaner elements on most New Holland tractors, the outer can be cleaned a number of times gently by air – always blowing from the inside out. (Refer to the operator's manual for details). The Element should be inspected by light afterwards; any light showing through the paper relegates the filter to the rubbish bin. The inner element should also be inspected thoroughly – any evidence of dirt on the inner element indicates that the outer element is damaged – Both need to be replaced at this point regardless of age. Either way the inner element should be replaced after 3 cleanings of the outer element. It is vital to ensure that the air cleaner elements are seated correctly and seal properly, the outer cover **MUST** be clipped in correctly – take care that this is done as misalignment of the cover can pull the elements off the sealing surface. If this all seems confusing, please consult your operators manual or feel free to call one of our workshop technicians at Tamworth or Gunnedah for assistance.

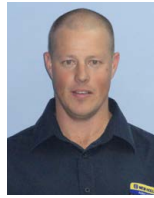

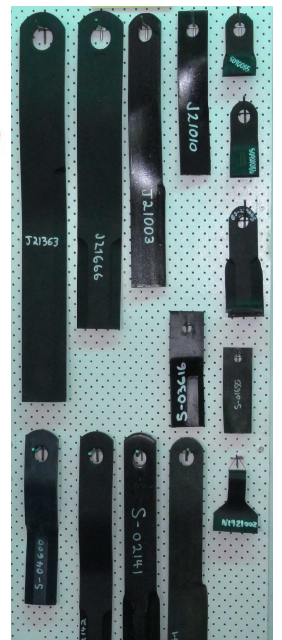

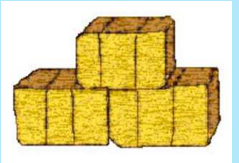
