The tractor is fitted with a Challenge/New Holland AP35 Plus front end loader with 4 in 1 bucket and pallet forks so they are now equipped to tackle a number of clean up jobs around the farm, from control of boxthorn through rock clearing, the New Holland TD5.110 will be kept fairly busy. Alston and Geraldine McKay are pictured at left with their new New Holland Boomer 50 FWA ROPS tractor. Alston has elected to fit a New Holland/Challenge APC27 level lift front end loader with 4 in 1 bucket and hay spears. The Boomer will be employed on the McKay's Mullaley property doing all sorts of odd jobs from cleaning up rocks to general cultivation and maintenance work. The McKays have also purchased a new Jarrett CP210 (2.1m) 7 tyne chisel plough to work with the tractor.



After many years of faithful service from their New Holland 317 small square baler, Allan Woollard and Paula Furlong of Nemingha have taken delivery of a new New Holland BC5060 small square baler, and they are now looking forward to reduced baling time and more reliability. The 317 always did a good job according to Allan but it was time to update and get the hay in the shed quicker. The new baler has been fitted with a hydraulic swing kit to allow quick and simple conversion from baling to travel position and a quarter turn bale chute on the rear to present the bales ready for the bale wagon to pick them up.



Steve and Jill Crocket (pictured at left) have been looking to reduce the time they spend cutting lucerne on their Nemingha farm. The New Holland 492 Haybine they have been using was not causing any problems and was still doing a great job, just a bit too slow. Steve looked at a number of machines and decided the New Holland H7230 Discbine with its reliability and speed would be the best machine for their operation. The backup and support for setup and ongoing operation from Goodwin Kenny's Hay technician Merv Leard was also an important factor in the decision. Depending on conditions cutting speeds of around 15km/hr are possible with the H7230. The new 2 point hitch just makes manoeuvrability around the farm much easier.



Tamworth Fodder Farms have upgraded one of their mower conditioners as part of a continuous machinery upgrading program. The New Holland 1411 Discbine was traded in on a new New Holland H7230 with the same disc cutting system, conditioning rollers and drive system as the old NH 1411. The two big differences are the Shock Pro hub system on the cutterbar modules and the 2 point hitch which makes left turns possible without catching the tractor tyre, this makes it easier to manoeuvre the machine in and out of fields and sheds. With a need for a bit more horsepower, Steve and Madonna Rowe have traded their New Holland TD80D on the new model New Holland TD5.100. The TD5 series is the upgrade from the TDD models that New Holland have had in the field for the last 8 or so years. The TD5 series has a fully redesigned cab which Steve said he was looking forward to, a bit more space in the cab, better visibility, improved cab isolation/mounting and better cab air filtration. The new powershuttle mounted on the steering column falls easily to hand and will make general operations easier. The engine is now Turbocharged with intercooler for improved responsiveness, fuel efficiency and reduced exhaust emissions. 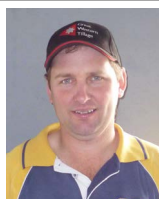

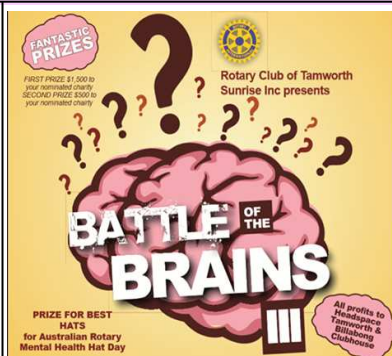
