



Two for One –

Out with the Red and in with the Blue

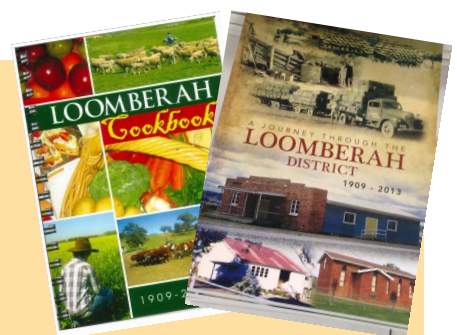
More Horsepower and Comfort

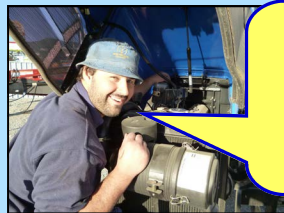
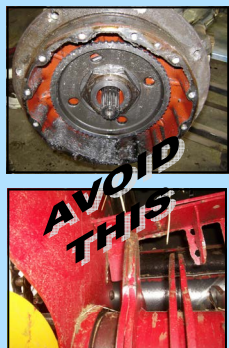

With the recent showers you will have noticed that the weeds have popped up with a vengeance – reports from some farmers are indicating that it may be a bad year for Saffron Thistle – so get in and spray early, if the weeds are a bit bigger – double your water rate for better coverage and keep the chemical rate at the top of the label rate for your specific situation and weed.

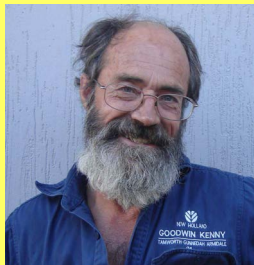

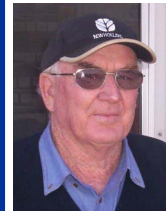
