Last week I was fortunate to be able to attend a New Holland Sales, Marketing and New Product Release Conference in Melbourne. The weather was cold but the venue at Aitken Hill, just to the north of Melbourne, was excellent with plenty of space for driving and trying out New Holland's newest products, from the CR series combine harvesters through a comprehensive range of hay and windrowing equipment to the full line of agricultural and compact tractors. We will see some new and interesting updates and models for 2015 from T8. SmartTrax Row Crop tracked tractors, the all new T4. and T5. series of utility tractors and New Holland's "Auto Command" constantly variable transmission which has been extended to include T6., T7. and T8. series tractors and major improvements and advances to New Holland's "Precision Land Management" systems.

Although it was a very fast paced itinerary, it was exceptionally well presented, extremely educational and worth every cold moment. I grabbed the opportunity to test drive a T7.200 Auto Command tractor, the same model Goodwin Kenny will be performing a series of "on farm" demonstrations with leading up to and following Agquip 2015.
