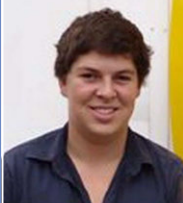

Bogballe to Duri

Rachel and Phil McRae needed a cost effective way to top-dress crop and pasture with various granular fertilisers.

The Bogballe twin disc spreader was chosen because of its accurate and reliable spreading pattern and the knowledge that the Bogballe was a high quality machine.

The M2plus has a capacity of 3,300litres or approximately 2.5t of urea or 3t of Super.

The McRaes chose to have their unit fitted with the Calibrator Icon control system – this allows for automated variable rate control as ground speed changes and with contour banks to contend with this was seen as essential to ensure accurate spreading rate. The ladder and lever action folding cover just add to the ease of use across the whole Bogballe package.



Fiat 411R gets a new Attachment

Ros and Mark Allen of Uralla have a growing problem with blady grass and other non-palatable grass and weeds starting to impact on their pastures. While slashing has been partly successful in the past Ros was looking for a more effective cut and with no windrow.

A Nobili BNE120 Mulcher at only 4' wide and less than 400kg was a suitable fit for the Fiat 411R. Nobili are a high quality Italian made Flail mulcher with low maintenance requirement, excellent build quality and after a few hours use Ros is very pleased with the result.



New Sprayer for Ben Knight at Kootingal

Ben needed to get his pasture spraying done in a timelier manner and has chosen a Silvan 800lt Pasturepak with a 10m boom to get around the farm quickly and efficiently.

The unit is fitted with Silvan's new 16lt foam marker which makes foam at the boom end similar to all of the bigger commercial units. A number of new and existing features of these balers were highlighted and the true benefits explained and worked through. There was some interesting conversation among current owners about the reliability and productivity of the new series of New Holland baler. One of the new features from 2016 build onwards that will have significant impact is the ability to change the core density and overall density of the bale from the monitor. This will help anyone baling for a Chaff mill, feeding out and straw bedding as the core of the bale can be made softer, to unroll easier.

Those present were also able to inspect a range of New Holland tractors on display.

Presenters on the day were Tony Peters (New Holland Product Manager - Combines, Balers & Haytools) & Ross Aylwin (CNH Service Technical & Training Specialist - ANZ, QPS Product Support APAC and former apprentice/mechanic/Service Manager at Goodwin Kenny), so it was good to see Ross showcasing his knowledge and talents. 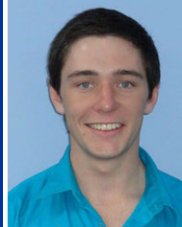

If you have non drip nozzle bodies you should also remove the cap and inspect the diaphragm, clean and reassemble.

PLEASE take the time to run your sprayer with clean water to make sure everything is correct BEFORE you put chemical into the tank.

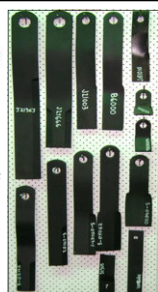

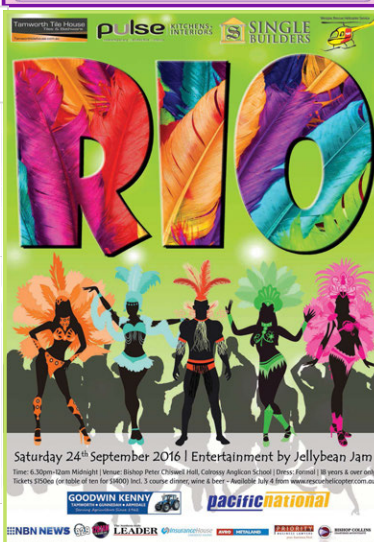

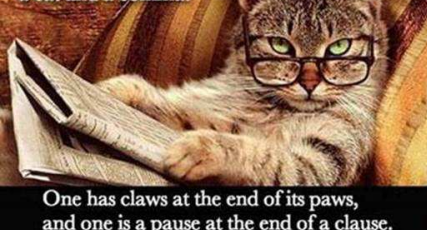
