Making Hay while the sun shines

Harley Hay is the new share farmer at the Tamworth Regional Council Waste Water Re-use farm behind the airport in Tamworth. With 13 pivot irrigators and 1300 acres of crop to grow, cut and bale a sizeable list of very specific machinery was required to make this hay in a timely manner. The New Holland Windrower was identified as the machine of choice to cut all the crop, mainly Lucerne and Oats that will be used within their



organisation and sold as feed for the horse industry. The New Holland SR240 is the biggest of the New Holland machines and has been coupled with the New Holland Durabine 419

disc cutting Front. The Chevron patterned steel conditioning rollers were specified to overcome wear issues on the farm and the high volume of work involved.

Bogballe at Breeza

Andrew Pursehouse of Breeza Station recently took delivery of a Bogballe 5550 Litre M6W Plus, 3 Point Linkage Spreader. This machine was demonstrated after the Ag-Quip Field Days by Colin Mitchell from Techgrow International and Peter Kenny from Goodwin Kenny Gunnedah. The Spreader is controlled through the ISOBUS terminal of the tractor and is fully automatic. The spinners are hydraulically driven to 650 RPM, this enables the machine to achieve a 36 metre spread width. Andrew and staff are able to cover up to 100 hectares per hour with this machine.

Bogballe to Nundle

Having recently taken over the running of Barry Station, Craig Maher (Manager) has drawn on his previous experience and specified a Bogballe M2 Base fertiliser spreader. The unit will be used primarily for spreading Super across the property. In some of the steeper country the 42m spread width will be helpful to reduce the tractor passes required.

With a capacity of 2 tonne the Bogballe has a very accurate spreading pattern with On/Off functions controlled by a hydraulic ram. The cover will come in handy to protect fertiliser from those sudden weather changes that could leave Craig a long way from a shed. Pictured is Craig Maher with his son, Isaac.



A John Shearer Pasture Drill for the Upper Hunter

Looking to improve pastures on a couple of areas on his farms in the Moonan Flat and Ellerston areas, Bruce McRae had done research on the type of drill that would perform best and then decided on the John Shearer Single Disc Pasture Drill. With years of tried and tested performance this drill will ensure good results in many soil types and conditions.

The machine has 16 single discs spaced at 6" (150mm) across 3 bars, each disc is mounted on Spring release tine to keep it in place and allow flexibility. Pictured is Ben, Georgie & Bruce McCrae.

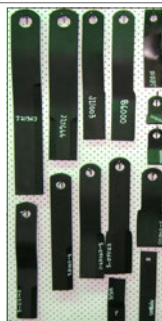
