



New Holland T6.140 Auto Command to Tintinhull

Quast Turkey Farm is a family owned and run business that has been operating at Tintinhull, near Tamworth, for over 60 years and 3 generations.

Col Quast Snr began raising Bronze Wing turkeys at Tintinhull in 1950 with strict husbandry protocols in place to ensure bird welfare as well as providing great tasting turkeys. The second generation, also Col Quast, now runs the business, with his son Colin James.

The Quast family has dealt with Goodwin Kenny for many years for a range of machinery and spare parts. Most recently Col was looking to have his header air conditioner serviced and contacted our Tamworth Service Manager, Ken Hatton, to carry out the job. He was so pleased with the level of service that when it came time to purchasing a new tractor he called in at the Tamworth office to discuss his requirements with our Salesman, Tony Housden.

Col needed a tractor with creeper gear to run his compost turner at the Turkey Farm. He also required Guidance with Auto Steer in the tractor.

The tractor chosen was a T6.140 Auto Command with 110 Horsepower.

The Auto Command CVT Transmission can go as slow as 20 metres per hour. It has Sidewinder II Armrest with Electronic Hydraulic Control levers and Intelliview II Screen. The tractor is also fitted with Terraglide Suspension Front Axle to reduce operator fatigue and increase traction. A New Holland Navigation Controller with FM750 display was fitted and integrated with the factory fitted Auto Steer System. The Quasts also took advantage of the low interest rate on offer by CNH Industrial Capital Finance and found the application and approval process very easy.

The tractor was fitted with a Challenge/New Holland AP38 Plus front end loader with 3rd function and 2460mm bucket. James also purchased an EZ Pilot steering system for Auto Guidance. 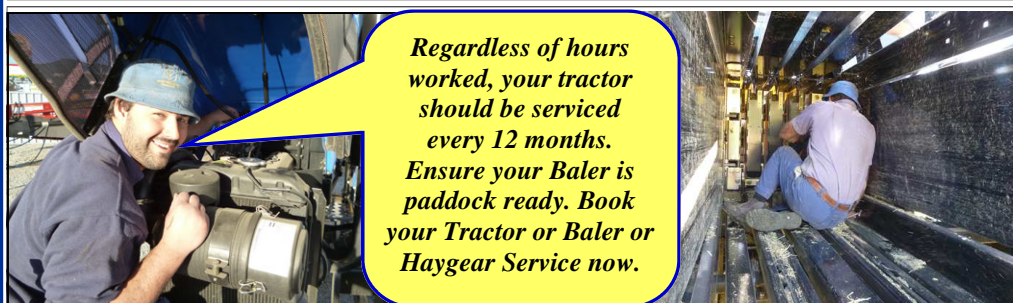

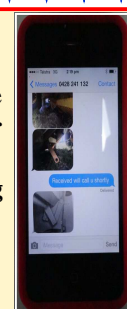

"There you go," she said. "I told you I could get that idiot to lower the price"

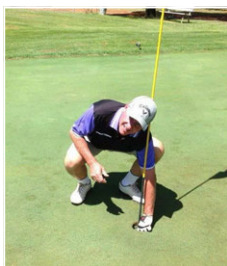
"See you later, Mom and Dad! Happy New year!"
