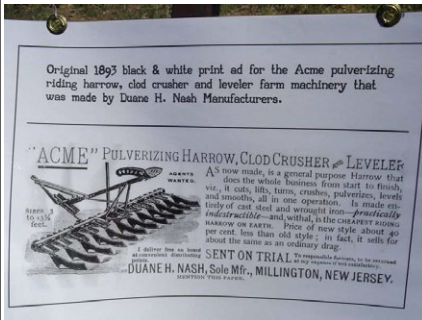

Brochure states that the machine "does the business from start to finish" and "is practically indestructible", "is the cheapest riding harrow on Earth". 124 years later - thank goodness we have come a long way - I can't envisage any of our customers wanting or willing to use something like this!



## OPERATOR MANUALS

A Manual is supplied with most new machines, you also get them when you buy a Toaster, Microwave or Washing Machine, but how many of them get read?

This is a just timely reminder that the Operator Manual will have information that may help you with the safe and efficient operation of your machinery. At Goodwin Kenny we have a large Digital Library of Manuals for New Holland Tractors, Balers and Mowers and we can reproduce a manual for you if you have lost yours.

We also have files on older machines - Rakes, Seeders, Slashers, Sprayers - call us if you need an Operator Manual.

This section covers the proper starting and transmission operation of the tractor.

### BEFORE STARTING THE ENGINE

Before starting your tractor each time, make the following checks. Also see Maintenance/Adjustments sections in this manual.

1. Make sure the tractor is properly lubricated and greased as described in the Lubrication/Maintenance section of this manual.
2. Check the engine oil level, engine coolant level, and transmission oil. Do not add engine oil unless the indicated level is below the add mark on the dipstick. See the Lubrication/Maintenance section of this manual.

3. Check that the tractor fuel tank is filled with clean fuel that meets the specifications given in this manual.

**NOTE:** Clean around the fuel tank cap before you remove the cap.

4. Check the fuel system, cooling system and engine for leaks.
5. Remove any water or sediment from the water trap of the fuel tank and primary filter.
6. Check the air pressure in the tires and check the wheel bolt torque.
7. Make sure the power takeoff guard is in the proper position.

**WARNING:** Before starting the engine, be sure all operating controls are in neutral or park position. This will eliminate accidental movement of the machine or start up of power driven equipment. SM306A

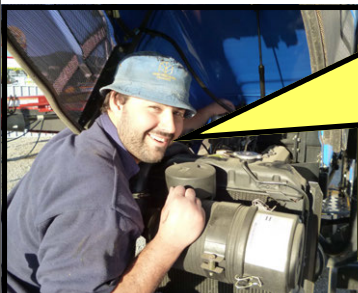
**WARNING:** Never operate the engine in a closed building. Proper ventilation is required under all circumstances. M142A

**WARNING:** ALWAYS sound horn before starting the machine. Make sure working area is clear of other persons, pets, tools, etc. before you start operating this machine. NEVER allow anybody in work area during machine operation. M804

### Daily Inspection

Walk around and visually inspect the tractor daily. Check for such items as hoses or wires rubbing against other components, oil leaks, trash buildup, loose bolts or anything that would affect the normal operation of the tractor.

Inspect the exhaust system and repair if leaking, failed or damaged.  
Make any necessary corrections before operating the tractor.



**Regardless of hours worked, your tractor should be serviced every 12 months. Ensure your Baler is paddock ready. Book your Tractor or Baler or Haygear Service now.**

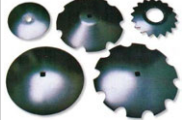

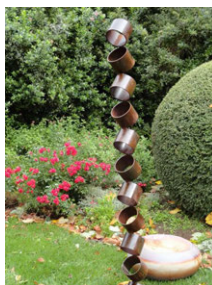

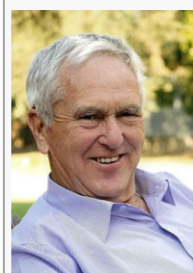
