3Point Linkage Counterweight - What is it? Why do you need it?

Serious lifting machinery has built-in counterweights - think about a Forklift, Telehandler or an Excavator - they all have a great big cast iron block built into the rear of the machine to counter-balance the weights being lifted on the front.


We take a farm tractor which is designed to pull, put a front end loader on the front and then try to lift with it, while there is some weight in the rear end of the tractor it is generally insufficient.

All quality Front End Loaders list a Rated operating Load with a 3pl Counterweight - by hanging the weight on the linkage - it pivots

over the rear axle and takes weight off the front axle as the loader tries to lift. Water in the tyres or Cast Iron weights on the rear wheels does not help, in actual fact it INCREASES the weight load on the front axle with only a small increase in stability.

By increasing the weight overhanging the rear axle the stability of the tractor increases, as the loader lifts, due to the change in the centre of gravity. The benefits are very clear - Safer and easier operation, reduced wear and stress on the front axle/tyres/steering etc.

Coolant controls corrosion (rust), assists cooling, resists freezing, reduces cavitation that leads to pitting, reduces the build-up of minerals, and much more.



If you have not replaced your coolant in the last 2 years – NOW is the time. Coolant does not last forever and just like oil, it must be changed regularly, either every 2 years or 1200 hours.

(Refer to Operator Manual) With new engine technologies comes new coolant technology – it is vital that you check the coolant required for your machine and get the correct one. It is also vitally important that you **do not mix coolants** with some of the new products.






The experts say that you should try new things all the time, and


