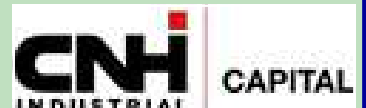

Michael (Mick) Kenny commenced work at Goodwin Kenny in 1979 beside his twin brother, Peter, and older brother, Mark.

He completed his Mechanical apprenticeship and worked on large Versatile tractors and Massey Ferguson headers. After 15 years at Goodwin Kenny he moved with his family to Orange and it was while there that he decided to join the Defence Force.

Mick progressed through the ranks quite quickly and attained the rank of Warrant Officer 2nd Class. After postings in peace keeping missions in Bougainville, East Timor and Iraq he was posted to Enoggera base in Brisbane. In 2011 he was diagnosed with cancer, which he battled quietly and bravely until it finally took his life on 14th February 2018 at Brisbane Royal Hospital.

Silvan Skid Sprayer

Bruce and Lindy O'Keefe (pictured) have chosen the Silvan

600 Litre Skid Mount Sprayer to tidy up some Blackberries and other weeds on a block at Duncan's Creek. The sprayer can be mounted onto a ute, or trailer behind the tractor, and is fitted with a Honda motor driving a Comet Diaphragm pump to push spray out of the twin 100 metre Reel Tuff Hose Reels and nylon hose.

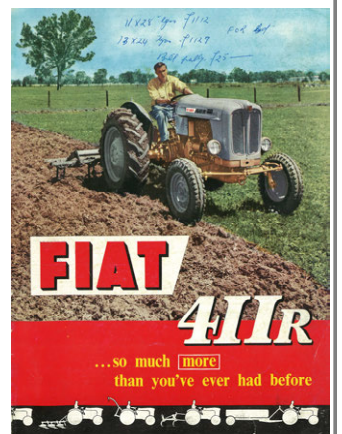
The Reel Tuff Reels are driven by a 12volt motor with gear reduction - are Australian made to meet Mine Specifications and have long range remote controllers. The reels are fully galvanised along with the sprayer frame.



How much have tractors and farm machinery changed over the last 55 years?

When Goodwin Kenny celebrated 50 years in business in 2012 we revisited a lot of our history through our business records, photos and brochures over the 5 decades. Then a few weeks ago I had another trip down that path when a friend, Robert Collins, from another long-time Bridge Street business - Collins Bros, dropped in a brochure that he had discovered in his files for a Fiat 411R tractor.

The sales brochures stated that the Fiat 411R tractor offered "so much more than you've ever had before". Features like "More Power...More Torque" which was actually 40 horsepower at 2200 rpm. The tractor also offered "exact gear and speed for every job" and retailed for 1130 pounds with an option of a belt pulley for an additional 25 pounds. In 1958 this tractor was a huge step forward for many farmers.

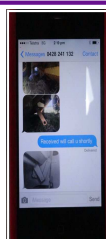

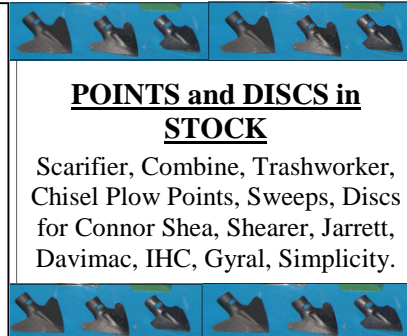

So you think you can dance?

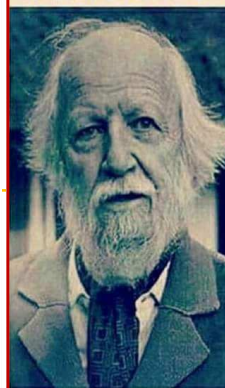
I have always wanted to learn to dance properly, so last year when a few friends decided to go to lessons, and after they organised a dance partner for me, I thought - why not!
