



Another New Holland tractor for Top Waterloo

David & Mel Benson and Graham & Julie Benson from Top Waterloo, Walcha have purchased a New Holland tractor for another property they have at Bundarra. Being some distance from the Walcha operation an additional tractor was always going to be required for the feeding and clearing work on this new farm at the moment. The New Holland T6020 Plus is very similar to their existing T6060 Elite tractor. The commonality of cab layouts, transmission, front end loader and tyre sizes means that driving one is the same as driving the other from an operator's perspective.

The New Holland T6020 Plus has a 4 cylinder 112hp mechanical pump engine with a 16 Forward x 16 Reverse Semi Powershift Transmission with Electro/Hydraulic F/R Shuttle Shift. The Challenge AP38 Plus front end loader gives a 1300kg legal lift for handling two Big Square bales and 1 Tonne Bulka Bags safely and with ease. Pictured at delivery/installation is David Benson.



Hustler Katipo 1150 sprayer heads to "Isis Hills" Timor

Ken Sylvester had been considering a new sprayer after a few dramas getting contractors to his farms at Timor and Bowmans Creek in the Upper Hunter when spraying was most beneficial. Between Ken and Isis Hills Farm Manager, Pat Faras, they decided that the Hustler was robust enough in both tank frame and boom to suit the varied country they need to spray.

The Katipo 1150 is fitted with a 1,150 litre main tank, 100 litre Flush Tank, Hand Wash Tank, Foam Marker and drum filling probe. The 12 metre Self Levelling Boom has hydraulic fold and lift with an accumulator providing boom suspension; all nozzles are fully protected behind the bottom frame of the boom. An ARAG Bravo 180s electronic spray controller provides variable rate control as the tractor increases or decreases speed. 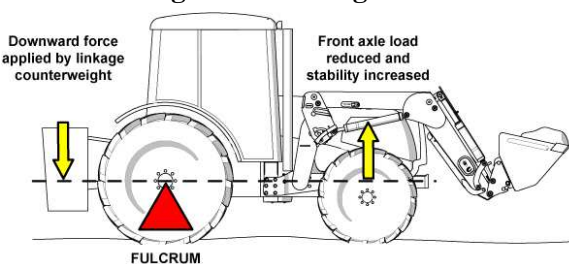
Counterweight to Coolah

Big bales are getting heavier as new balers are increasingly able to produce high density bales well over 600 kg each, in some cases in the high 700 kg range, so picking up two at a time in the paddock was presenting Tony Kurtz with a problem of being too light in the back end of his tractor. The only



solution that is successful is a 3 point linkage counterweight. Getting the job done quicker is also key to a profitable operation. Tony chose the Burder Ag Attachments 1,000 kg concrete filled block as the most effective solution for his operation. The Burder counterweight is slim shaped with limited rear protrusion. Tony is pictured with the counterweight in Tamworth.

over the rear axle and takes weight off the front axle as the loader tries to lift. Water in the tyres or Cast Iron weights on the rear wheels does not help, in actual fact it INCREASES the weight load on the front axle with only a small increase in stability. By increasing the weight overhanging the rear axle the stability of the tractor increases, as the loader lifts, due to the change in the centre of gravity. The benefits are very clear – Safer and easier operation, reduced wear and stress on the front axle/tyres/steering etc.

Serious lifting machinery has built-in counterweights – think about a Forklift, Telehandler or an Excavator – they all have a great big cast iron block built into the rear of the machine to counterbalance the weights being lifted on the front. We take a farm tractor which is designed to pull, put a front end loader on the front and then try to lift with it, while there is some weight in the rear end of the tractor it is generally insufficient.

All quality Front End Loaders list a Rated Operating Load with a 3pl Counterweight – by hanging the weight on the linkage – it pivots
